BECOME A LIFEGUARD

The American Red Cross Lifeguarding classes are designed to teach water safety and proper protocol when dealing with emergencies around water. The Red Cross blends both traditional lecture style along with hands-on training in order to teach you effective techniques to deliver prompt care to those in need. Upon successful completion of this course, you will be certified by the American Red Cross (ARC) in Lifeguarding/First Aid (valid for 2 years) and CPR/AED Professional Rescuer (valid for 1 year)

Fee: \$350

2019 Dates You must attend all 3 classes in your session- All classes are (1-9pm)

October- 10/6, 10/13, 10/20

December- 12/1, 12/8, 12/15

In order to successfully pass the course, each student must pass prerequisite skills:

Minimum age: 15 years (must be 15 by last day of class)

Swim 300 yards continuously:

Candidates must swim using the front crawl and breaststroke.

Tread water for 2 minutes:

Only using legs-- arms not allowed.

Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds:

Swim the length of the pool, surface dive to the bottom of the pool and retrieve a 10-pound brick. With the brick, swim back on your back to the starting point with both hands holding the brick and keeping the face at or near the surface. Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.
